COURSE SELECTION PROCESS YEAR 11 2010

To ensure you maximise the opportunity to select courses, please follow these instructions carefully:

1. Read the course selection book (parents and students)
2. Make an appointment with either of the career advisers if you need some guidance (optional). Please do this before 8th August.
3. Ensure that at least one parent/carer attends the Course Selection Parent Information Evening on Tuesday 4th August. (7.00pm in the Chapel).
4. After July 21st (First day of Term 3), call Mrs Jill Dickinson (9204 9443) to make a Course Selection Interview time (interviews are available before, during and after school).
5. A parent/carer must attend the Course Selection Interview with the student.
6. These interviews are compulsory and will be held between Monday 10th August and Friday 28th August.
7. Students may not select subjects for which the prerequisite has not been met. Achievement of prerequisites will be determined by Year 10 Semester 1 report results.
8. Complete the required sections (see below) of this form by following the instructions given.
9. Bring the *completed* form and your Semester 1 report to the interview. Forms will be collected from the student at this point.
10. In late Term 4, students will be advised of their subjects for 2010.
