EXPLANATION OF ELECTIVE TYPES

Sequential Subjects:

These subjects must be studied in numerical order. For example, a student must do Drama 1 before doing Drama 2.

Non-Sequential Subjects:

These subjects may be studied in any order, at any time. For example, a student may do Outdoor Education B in Year 8, then Outdoor Education A in Year 9.

EXPLANATION OF ELECTIVE SELECTION

In 2010, students may choose one of the following alternatives for elective selection.

ALTERNATIVE 1

FOUR semester length electives **OR**

ALTERNATIVE 2

TWO semester length electives and **ONE** year long elective **OR**

1. Place a tick against the 4 elective subjects that you studied during Year 8 in Semester 1 and Semester 2 (use the 'Previously Studied' column) and place a tick against the LOTE subject that you studied.

2. Do not select subjects that you have already studied.
3. Number (1 - 3) your top 3 choices for The Arts. Number 1 should be your first preference.
4. Number (1 - 3) your top 3 choices for Technology & Enterprise.
5. In the Pref. column, number your top 7 subjects from all available subjects. Number 1 should be your first preference.
6. Using a highlighter, highlight each of your seven selections including the subject title, subject code, preference and prerequisite for all 7 choices.
7. Sign at the bottom of the page (student, PCG and parent) and complete the contact details.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All efforts will be made to place students in the order of their preferences.
- Students will study a total of 2 elective subjects each semester for three periods. They are required to fill in additional elective choices, as the College reserves the right to withdraw subjects offered for Year 9 2010 if there is insufficient demand.
